## **ArtsBus Program Guidelines**

## **Program Overview**

ArtsWave's ArtsBus Program (formerly ArtLinks) is emergency transportation service funding provided to eligible schools offering expanded opportunities for connecting students to the arts from schools possessing a nonprofit status and qualifying with Title I designation.

## **Purpose**

The ArtsBus Program is designed to mitigate the financial barrier of transportation associated with arts and cultural education experiences for those schools and/or students that are economically disadvantaged.

## **Who May Apply**

To be eligible for the ArtsBus Program, a school must meet all the following requirements:

- Possess a nonprofit status and currently hold a Title I designation, with 50% or more of their students being provided with nutritional support through the National School Breakfast and Lunch Programs.
- Be based in the Interstate 275 Loop-Ohio, which includes the following counties: Clermont and Hamilton Counties in Ohio; Boone, Campbell, and Kenton Counties in Kentucky; and Dearborn County in Indiana.
- Embody ArtsWave's commitment to access, equity, and inclusiveness.

ArtsWave will not award support to entities that, in their constitution, bylaws, or practices, discriminate against a person or group because of age, race, national origin, ethnicity, gender, disability, sexual orientation, political affiliation, or religious belief. In doing so, we seek to promote respect for all people.

#### **ArtsBus Program Periods**

Bi-annual applications will be accepted on a rolling basis, requested for either the September-December or January-May program period funding.

#### **ArtsBus Funding**

A school may apply for up to \$300 per eligible arts activity/experience that meets the program criteria for emergency transportation service funding, limited to no more than two applications per program period.

Each eligible arts activity/experience must be applied for separately.

## Applicants are responsible for making all transportation and destination arrangements.

#### **Eligible Requests**

Eligible requests for funding:

- Must fall within the general school calendar year.
- Must be for those schools within the Interstate 275 Loop-Ohio with a Title I
  designation and 50% or more of their students being provided with nutritional
  support through the National School Breakfast and Lunch Programs
  (documentation required).
- Must provide a reason for the transportation funding request (e.g. budget curtailment).
- Must be used for field trip-related transportation expenses only, and may not be used for other related costs or activities (documentation required).

# **Application Instructions**

All application materials must be submitted via the online grantmaking system Submittable. First-time applicants will be directed to establish a <u>Submittable account</u> which should be created with login credentials that are specific to the school, not the individual applying, so that all applications remain under a single account.

Once created, ArtsWave will not have access to your account or credentials, so please retain that information in a secure place where it can be retrieved by approved school personnel.

Each bi-annual application will request the following (each eligible arts activity/experience must be applied for separately):

- School name and contact information
- School District
- School's State District ID number
- Is the school within the Interstate 275 Loop-Ohio with a Title I designation and 50% or more of their students being provided with nutritional support through the National School Breakfast and Lunch Programs

- Upload of Title I designation documentation
- Description of the arts activity/experience, including arts/cultural venue name and location
- Reason for transportation funding request
- Date of the arts activity/experience
- Number of students participating in and being transported to the arts activity/experience
- Funding request (can be up to \$300 per application; applicant is limited to no more than two applications per program period)
- Upload of actual transportation cost (e.g. a purchase order, written estimate, transportation company contract, vehicle rental agreement, or letter from an authorizing school official)

September-December Bi-Annual Application Opens August 15, 2023

Closes November 30, 2023

January-May Bi-Annual Application Opens December 15, 2023

Closes April 30, 2024
